#### **UNDERSTAND THE PROMPT (1 HOUR)**

- Read the essay question carefully.
- Highlight the key words (like "leadership," "community," or "goals").
- Make sure you know what the scholarship committee is really asking.

## **BRIANSTORM YOUR STORY (1-2 HOURS)**

- Write down 3 moments from your life that connect to the prompt.
- Pick the one that shows growth, impact, or resilience.
- Remember: Committees want to know who you are, not just your grades.

#### **DRAFT YOUR ESSAY (3-4 HOURS)**

Use this simple outline:

- Hook start with a powerful sentence or short story.
- Body give 2–3 clear examples that connect to the prompt.
- Conclusion show how this scholarship will help your future.

## **EDIT & POLISH (2-3 HOURS)**

- Read your essay out loud.
- Cut out extra words.
- Ask a teacher, parent, or friend to read it.
- Make sure it's clear, honest, and under the word limit.

Quick Tip Box: Good essays don't try to be perfect, they try to be real.
